Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer has implemented a new year-to-date format for reports. Please refer to the December Treasurer's report. There is a small amount (\$20) owed to the BAS Student Activity Fund (Video Productions) from the sale of 4 DVDs (\$10 each) during the Fall Sports Banquet; Boosters Club and Video productions split the proceeds from the video sales. A monetary request was submitted for the home wrestling meet hospitality room. As of 31 December, the balance in the Boosters' AFCU checking account is \$5311.12 and in the savings account \$511.89.

Athletic Director

The ice machine in the gym remains broken. The Athletic Director thanked the Booster Club for planning to provide breakfast to the 50+ athletes gathered from multiple schools for the wrestling meet 12 January. BAS will be requesting community support to house athletes traveling from Menwith Hill for that home basketball game. The wrestling finals are scheduled for 9 February at Alconbury. In response to a question concerning the European Basketball Tournament, the BAS athletes will leave the day before play begins.
